

## **Crescent Lake Cabin** **Your Natural Retreat**



Here are some answers to Frequently Asked Questions about the cabin. Hopefully this will help you plan your trip.

### **Kitchen**

Q: How big is the fridge, was planning on bring a weeks worth of groceries.

A: It's medium sized. Much, much bigger than a "dorm" fridge, but smaller than mine at home. About 5.5 feet tall, normal width?

Q: What appliances are in the kitchen?

A: Stove, oven, fridge, microwave.

Q: What else is in the kitchen?

A: Coffee makers, coffee grinder, many pots and pans, dishes for about 10 people, silverware for more, cups, glasses, It is fairly well stocked. Please ask if you have other questions.

### **Supplies**

Q: Do we need to bring towels?

A: No, they are provided.

Q: Is there enough trash bags, paper towels for the week or should we bring some?

A: There should be enough.

Q: There is a washer and dryer right? Should we bring laundry soap.

A: There is a washer and dryer. Please do bring your own soap, although a previous guest may have left some.

Q: What should I do if supplies such as propane, paper towels, or toilet paper run out?

A: I do my best to keep the supplies stocked, and there are extras in the cabinets in the kitchen, bathroom, and downstairs bedroom. However, if supplies do run out, please purchase what you need at the Odell Sportsman and let me know ASAP so I can get the cabin restocked. Then send me the receipt and I will reimburse you.

### **Fires and Wood**

Q: Can we build an out door campfire?

A: Yes, there is a fire pit for campfires. Please make sure to fully extinguish the fire when you are not there, and keep the fires small as forest fires are a real danger.

Q: Do I need to bring wood?

A: Wood is provided for heating the cabin. For campfires, I prefer that you use other wood, such as branches. Using some of the heating wood for campfires is OK, just in moderation.

#### **Nearby services**

Q: Remind me how far to the closest grocery store.

A: There is a convenience store 1 mile away called the Odell Sportsman. It has some things like milk, beer, wine, cereal, coffee, eggs, and aspirin. However, it does not have produce. There are some stores 15 minutes away in Crescent / Gilchrest, but I'm not familiar with what they stock. The closest real grocery store is 30 minutes away in La Pine.

Q: What restaurants are nearby?

A: Moon Shine Cafe is across from the Odell Sportsman, 1 mile away. It server lunch (burgers, etc) and has fantastic home-made pies. The Odell Sportsman has convenience store hot food. The tavern Manly's is also nearby. Crescent Lake Lodge and Odell Lake Lodge both have restaurants, about 5-10 minutes away. Crescent/Gilchrest also have restaurants and taverns.

#### **Outdoors**

Q: There is a BBQ on the deck right? Is it propane?

A: There is a propane BBQ and an extra tank. There is also a cleaning brush, etc.

Q: I know I asked about outdoor chairs, but I can remember how many you have.

A: There is a table with an umbrella and with 5 chairs, and a few other outdoor chairs.

#### **Indoors**

Q: What entertainment is inside the cabin?

A: There is a DVD player and TV. There is no television reception, so bring DVDs. There are a few board games and puzzles. There is a stereo that can play CDs from the DVD player, and also a jack to plug into iPods so you can play your own tunes.
